NEW: Church leaders Ceasefire Pilgrimage on Parliament Hill On May 22, church leaders and members from a very wide range of denominations marched to Parliament Hill to call on Canada to do more towards a ceasefire between Israel and Gaza. Occupied Palestinian Territories, the release of all captives, and immediate humanitarian aid. They also called on Canada to end all military sales to Israel. "Canada can do better. We can avoid being complicit in genocide by imposing a comprehensive and binding embargo on military trade with Israel," said Moderator Lansdowne. "I join here with my siblings in faith and our membership gathered here in Ottawa today, to not just wish for a better world, but to actively advocate for a just peace in Palestine and Israel.
